

## **Guidelines for Cumberland Pointe Health Campus Worship Service**

Thank you for taking this opportunity to bless the residents of [Cumberland Pointe Health Campus](#) (formerly George Davis Manor) with the love of Christ. If you've never done this before, don't be intimidated—you'll find this to be a very rewarding experience. Just do your preparation and bathe this commitment in prayer, and God will bless the work.

Families are welcomed, and the commitment, time wise, is a relatively small one. It goes for 30 to 45 minutes beginning at 3:00PM, and so falls between the lunch and dinner hours for minimal impact on those plans. If you're planning a special program requiring more time, just contact CPHC at the number below.

CPHC has a dedicated chapel that's very conducive to worship—no distractions or interruptions. The chapel is located adjacent to the main entrance so it's easy to find—just go in the main doors and it's immediately to your right. Attendants are on hand to help you with any needs you might have. The songbooks are binders located in the cabinets under the windows of the chapel. The attendees (residents) generally don't have Bibles, so take that into account when you prepare and present (Don't use expressions like "Please turn to..." or "Please follow along as I read...". Just tell them where you're reading from.)

The service normally consists of a welcome and introductions; a prayer; singing a few songs from their songbook (duplicated in this binder so that you may preselect in your prep); a Scripture reading; a 10 to 15 minute devotional from the Bible; and a short fellowship time for interaction with the audience. The more attending from your KSBC group, the better, but the following is a suggested list of the active participating roles:

(You can combine roles if you're short handed or if you feel it would enhance the flow of the service.)

- Someone to welcome and make the introductions.
- Someone to pray.
- Someone to lead the singing (if you have a piano player, the chapel has a piano—or you can go a cappella). You can also opt to provide special music if you have talent of that sort in your group, or you may solicit outside your group for this.
- Someone to read the Bible passage.
- Someone to present the devotional from God's Word.
- Everyone to participate in the "fellowship" time.
